**NEW LONDON'S LEVY ALLOWANCE HAS BEEN UNDER 1/2 OF A PERCENT 9 OUT OF THE LAST 11 YEARS  
 (and under 3/4% in 2018 & 2019) It is unsustainable to maintain services with annual inflation at 2%-9%**

The City has made cuts due to shared revenue cuts and strict levy limits.

In the early-mid 2000 New London had 8 FT street operators/truck drivers, today the city has 5

New London had 5 FT park caretakers, today the city has 3

New London had 2 Superintendents, 1 Street Superintendent & 1 Park Superintendent, today the city has 1 Street & Park Superintendent.

**EARLY 2000'S = 15 Full Time DPW/Parks Employees VS. 2022 = 9 Full Time DPW/Parks Employees**

**Due to levy restriction and shared revenue reductions New London has lost 6 Full Time Employees.....  
 40% OF NEW LONDON'S DPW/PARKS FULL TIME WORK FORCE HAS BEEN CUT IN THE LAST 20 YEARS**
